CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT

This contract made and entered into the 26th day of February, 2018, by and between the Port of Lewiston, Lewiston, Idaho, hereinafter called "Owner" and Summit Utility Contractors, LLC hereinafter called "Contractor".

WITNESSETH: It is hereby mutually understood and agreed by and between the Owner and the Contractor as follows:

- 1. **CONTENTS OF CONTRACT:** The contract shall consist of;
 - a. This document, including amendments thereto;
 - b. The bid proposal and project description/general scope of work
 - c. Approved OPM Design
 - d. Avista Route Application approval

ALSO APPLIES BUT NOT ATTACHED TO CONTRACT:

- e. All applicable State, Local and Federal Laws and Regulations and permits.
- II. WORK TO BE PERFORMED: Contractor shall commence and complete the construction described as follows:

18 FIB -- Fiber Optic Construction to 1230 Main St, Lewiston, Idaho

Hereinafter called the project and all extra work in connection therewith. The Contractor shall perform the contract in accordance with terms and conditions set forth in this contract.

The Contractor's scope of work shall include but is not limited to the scope of work delineated in the bid proposal and project description/general scope of work.

III. PRICE: Contractor shall perform the contract for the amount specified in the bid attached,

\$8,650.00 (Eight Thousand, Six Hundred Fifty Dollars and 00/100), which includes all labor, materials and applicable sales tax.

Contractor shall, at its own expense, furnish all services and the materials, supplies, machinery, equipment, tools, superintendent, labor, insurance, and other accessories necessary to complete the said project. The Contractor is required to provide a Contract Bond to qualify for periodic pay estimates on this project.

- IV. **INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS:** Prior to performance under this Contract, the contractor shall, at its own cost and expense, carry and maintain the insurance coverage listed below with insurers authorized to do business in the state(s) of operation.
 - a. Commercial General Liability Insurance covering claims for bodily injury, death, personal injury or property damage (including loss of use) occurring or arising out of the license, use or occupancy of any premises in connection with this Contract by the Contractor, including coverage for premises-operation, products/completed operations and


contractual liability with respect to the liability assumed by the Contractor hereunder. The limits of insurance shall not be less than:

Each Occurrence	\$ 1,000,000
General Aggregate	\$ 2,000,000
Products/Completed Operations Aggregate	\$ 2,000,000
Personal & Advertising Injury	\$ 1,000,000

- b. Workers' compensation Insurance with statutory limits as required in the state(s) of operation; and providing coverage for any employee entering onto any premises in connection with this Contract, even if not required by statute. Standard Employers' Liability limits are: \$100,000 each accident; bodily injury by disease \$100,000 each employee; bodily injury by disease \$500,000 policy limit or "Stop Gap" insurance with a limit of not less than \$1,000,000.
- c. Comprehensive Automobile Liability Insurance covering the ownership, operation and maintenance of all owned, non-owned and hired motor vehicles used in connection with this Contract, with limits of at least \$1,000,000 per occurrence for bodily injury and property damage.
- d. Such insurance shall not be canceled or materially altered without the insurer first giving thirty (30) days written notice to the Port of Lewiston, 1626 6th Ave N, Lewiston, ID 83501.
- e. Such insurance shall be primary and non-contributory to any of the Port of Lewiston's insurance coverage.
- f. In respect to those insurances described in the subparts a and c of the Liability Coverage Requirements provision above, the Port shall be named as an additional insured in respect to operations arising out of this Contract. A copy of the Additional Insured Endorsement is required to be submitted to the Port of Lewiston along with the Certificate of Insurance.
- g. Insurance for subcontractors: If the contractor subcontracts any portion of this Contract, the Contractor shall include all subcontractors under its policies or shall require separate certificates of insurance and policy endorsements from each subcontractor. Insurance coverage provided by subcontractors as evidence of compliance with the insurance requirements of this contract shall be subject to all of the requirements stated herein.
- V. **COMPLIANCE WITH STATE LAWS:** It is understood and agreed that all statues of the State of Idaho relating to public works project applicable hereto shall be fully complied with and fulfilled by the Contractor, including the applicable Federal Laws, and upon contractor's failure to do so the Owner may terminate this contract as provided for under the laws of the State of Idaho and the terms of this contract. Contractor certifies that it has an Idaho Contractor License as required by Idaho Code §54-5201, et seq) and that it hold an Idaho Public Works Contractor License. Contractor shall provide the Port of Lewiston a copy of their current Idaho Public Works Contractor License prior to commencement of work.

- VI. **PAYMENT:** The Owner agrees to pay the Contract in current funds, after completion for the performance of the contract as outlined in the accepted Bid Proposal of the Contract provisions/Contract Documents, and for any extra work or material as applies and as preapproved by the OWNER in writing. Progress payments shall be allowed with the posting of a contract bond.
- VII. **COMMENCEMENT OF WORK:** The Contractor hereby agrees to commence work under this contract promptly upon receipt of written "Notice to Proceed" from the Owner or on the date specified in the "Notice to Proceed' and to fully complete the project **NO LATER THAN MARCH 15, 2018**. No weather days are allowed under this contract.
- VIII. **LIQUIDATED DAMAGES:** If the Contractor fails to complete the work or deliver the requested material within the time specified above in this Contract, the Contractor shall pay liquidated damages at the rate of \$100 per day beyond the set completion date.

By executing this document below, the parties to this contract signify that they have read the contents of this contract understand it and agree to be bound by its terms.
